





Income is not Wealth






Tax Burden is more for Low-Income Households

Composition of Low- and High-Income Households


By race or ethnicity, 2018

Homeownership Rate by Race in Maryland






Housing Cost Burden - Homeowners by Race in Maryland





Households with Zero Net Worth by Race in Maryland




Business Ownership by Race in Maryland

Economic Impact of Closing the Racial Equity Gap (by 2050)

- \$8 trillion gain in GDP
- \$191 billion spent on food
- \$500 billion on housing
- \$52 billion on apparel
- \$259 billion on transportation

- \$77 billion on entertainment
- \$450 billion annual increase in Federal Tax Revenue
- \$100 billion annual increase in State and Local Tax Revenue




